Due to organizational restraints at the moment we are going for a maximum of 60 student participants from abroad. The CONGRESS FEE is only 75€ per person. Bed & breakfast for students, welcome and farewell dinner, barbecue party as well as excursions are included. For all lecturers (and other non students participants) we will arrange reasonable accommodation in a hotel on extra costs (ca. 46€ p.p./p.n.) in Jena. Travel and hotel expenses must be covered by the participants or the
