Some data from Unaforis

- ❖ 1029 people (859 registered)
- ❖ 41 countries represented (42% French)
- ❖ 432 contributions presented (640 abstracts sent)

Conference structure

3 plenary sessions

- Three keynotes and 1 round table

Contributions presented in four formats

- Symposia (21)
- Workshops (46)
- Parallel sessions (328)
- Poster and video (34)

Four main streams

1. methods and pedagogy of social work education:

130 oral presentations; 27 workshops; 13 Symposia

2. social work curricula:

53 oral contribution, 11 workshops; 5 Symposia

3. Ethics in social work education:

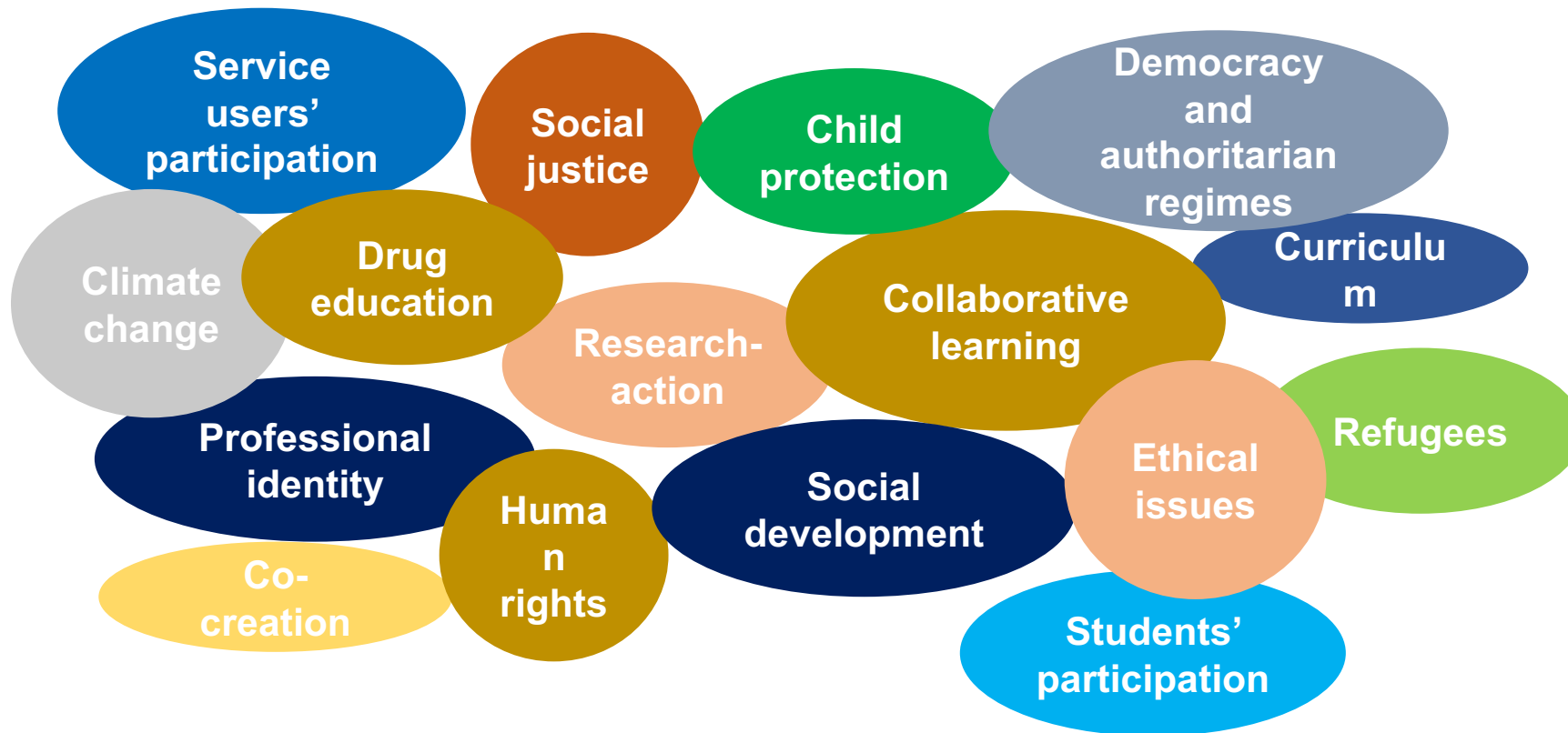
33 oral contribution, 3 Workshop, 1 Symposia

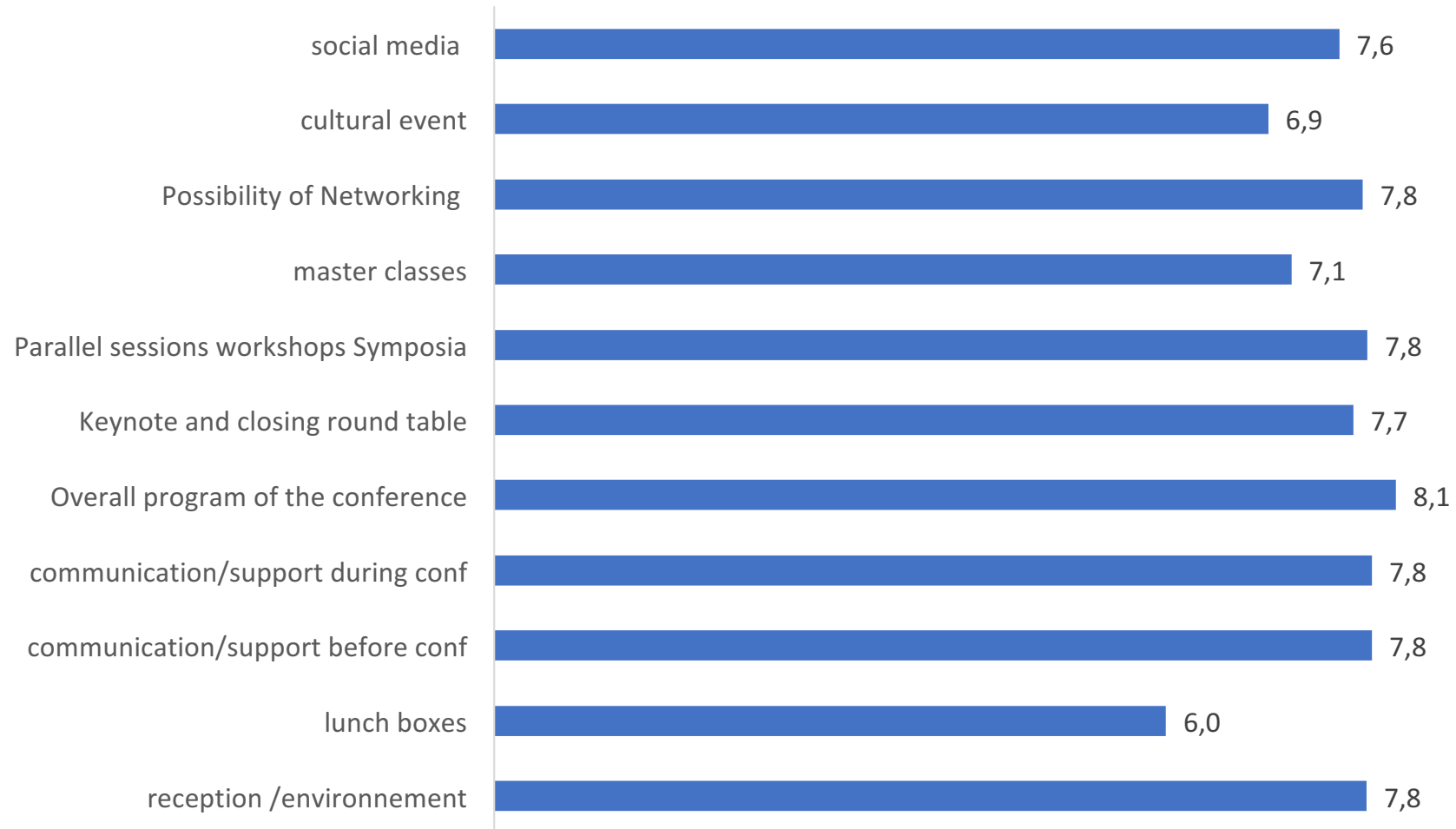

Chairs' evaluations

- 75% sessions were attended by more than 15 people
- 80% of chairs appreciated the framework provided by the SC
- 65% paper well received . 14% very well received
- 50% chairs experienced problems in chairing --> Mainly, shortage of time, problems with translation and technical equipment (see tab 11 /12 ; 17-18)
